

# Ganja Oil Vape FAQ

## Direction of Use

Vape carts are 510 threaded and are compatible with 510 threaded vape batteries, buttonless or button-operated.

**Buttonless:** screw vape cart onto battery and inhale.

**Button-operated:** first make sure the battery is turned on, press button and inhale.

**Recommended dose:** initial 2 to 3 seconds inhale and then as needed. Recommended mouth to lung (MTL) technique for best taste and flavour.

**Vape cart resistance:** average 1.5 ohms  $\Omega \pm 0.2$

**Best Battery Voltage:** 2.7v to 2.9v

Do not overuse the cart, if it gets hot it may cause it to leak and/or clog. Some carts contain a cotton wick and may cause it to burn leaving a bad after taste.

## Ingredients

- 100% full spectrum ganja oil.  
Made in Jamaica from locally cultivated ganja.
- Supercritical CO<sub>2</sub> extracted and winterized.  
(Some may contain Δ9THC distillate for increased potency).
- Does not contain any non-cannabis derived additives, medium chain triglyceride (MCT) oil, propylene glycol (PG), polyethylene glycol (PEG), vegetable glycerin (VG), vitamin-e acetate or food grade terpenes.

## Potency

- ◇ Range from mid 50% to high 60% Δ9THC  
(each 0.5 gram contains ≈ 250 - 350 mg of Δ9THC)  
with ≈ 10 to 15% terpene content.

## Troubleshooting

### Vape battery lights flashing when inhaling:

- ✓ First check that the battery is fully charged.
- ✓ If fully charged check that both the battery contact plate and the bottom of the vape cart is clean. If dirty, clean with a cotton swab dampened (not dripping wet) with alcohol. Let dry before use.
- ✓ Do not overtighten cart to vape battery.
- ✓ Try a different battery with higher voltage.
- ✓ If it's hard to inhale the cart may have become clogged. Try using a button activated battery as some have a pre-heat function to get the oil flowing again.

### Battery not charging:

- ✓ Check that the contact plate on the vape battery is clean.
- ✓ For vape batteries with a spring contact plate, check that the plate has not become stuck.
- ✓ Try a different USB charger.
- ✓ If still not charging then the internal battery may have gone bad, they have a typical shelf life of 1 to 2 years depending on use and charge cycles.



## Storage

- Keep in a cool dry place out of sunlight. Do not leave in any hot areas, i.e. vehicle.
- Store upright for long term storage or otherwise mentioned (new full ceramic carts can be stored with mouthpiece facing down to prevent leaking through the bottom).
- Keep out of reach of children and pets.
