



All Together Canadian Birthright Israel Trip!

Dates: May 13 2026- May 21, 2026

Departure and Return city:

Pearson Toronto Airport

Eligibility:

- must be between ages 18-32
- having at least one Jewish parent
- identifying as being Jewish
- never been to Israel on an organized trip after high school
- not having lived in Israel after the age of 12 for more than 3 months.
- *Our group leader Shawn Kendal will reach out to set up Zoom interviews and info session with applicants and parents.*

Activity Highlights:

- ✓ **Classic Sights** You'll see Tel Aviv, Jerusalem, float in the Dead Sea, the Negev, Golan Heights and more!
- ✓ **Camel Care** A Tailor Made staple activity where participants visit a camel "spa," feed, interact and take photos.
- ✓ **Emek Hashalom (Valley of Peace) Farm**-hands on farming and craft experience like in ancient times, including olive and wine press and work in fields.
- ✓ **Nachal Hashofet** Explore the first accessible natural hiking trail in Israel
- ✓ **Invitation to Silence** captivating non-verbal tour and activity with deaf guides at Israel Children's Museum
- ✓ **Meaningful volunteering** give back to Israel

What to Expect:

The Israel All Together Birthright Trip is geared toward participants with ASD (Autism Spectrum Disorder) as well as participants with IDD (intellectual/developmental disabilities). While we provide increased number of staff, all participants are expected to require minimal support for activities of daily living.

Our vision for this trip is to provide participants with an exceptional Birthright Israel educational experience tailored to accommodate their social, emotional, and physical needs. This trip, in most ways, is like any other Birthright Israel trip.

The main differences include: higher participant-to-staff ratio, unique itinerary elements and accommodations such as minimizing hotel/room transfers and moving through activities at a more relaxed pace.
