Call for Proceedings

The *Proceedings of the New York State Association* publishes the Proceedings for the Convention of the New York State Communication Association. Papers accepted for publication appear in the issue associated with the Convention at which they were presented. All papers, including undergraduate student papers, are blind peer-reviewed.

Research papers presented at the recent 82st Annual Conference (2024) of the New York State Communication Association – **GENERATIVE CommunicAltion** – are now being accepted for blind peer review for the conference Proceedings. We urge you to contribute your work. Submissions will be accepted until **March 10, 2025**.

We also encourage those who presented on the GIFTS (Great Ideas for Teaching Students) panel to submit their work as well.

Submission Guidelines for Research Papers

Please make sure that the length of your paper does not exceed 25 double-spaced pages (not including references, tables, graphs, figures). The paper must follow APA format and please include a running head as well as an abstract of 100 words or less. Please indicate, on the title page, the year in which your paper was presented (for example, “2024”).

Submission Guidelines for GIFTS

Please make sure the length of your submission does not exceed 2 pages (please double-spaced). It must follow APA format and include an abstract of 100 words or less. Please also indicate, on the title page, the year of your presentation (for example, “2024”). Remember that the audience for your GIFT is the instructor who will be employing this activity in her/his course. In your submission, please be sure to include (a) the title of your GIFT, (b) the purpose of your GIFT, (c) the link between your GIFT and a particular course or series of courses, (d) the details of the GIFT itself, and € a list of at least three additional references so that the instructor can engage in further research about your GIFT. Submissions will be reviewed using standard publication criteria.
