

To be scored under the open numerical judging system. Spreads not to exceed fence height. The First round to be over a Classic-type course of 8-12 fences. The top 12 will return to jump a Second round. The Second round may include handy-type elements such as roll-backs and hand galloping and trotting a fence. Scores will be added to determine the winners. Three horses must complete the first round in order to fill the division. A rider must compete in a minimum of three James Rice Derby's at the same height to be eligible for a year end award. The year end awards may be split into Professional and Junior/Amateur sections if entries warrant.



## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Every class offered herein will be conducted and judged under the current rules of the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF) and the Long Island Professional Horseman's Association.
2. All points won at this show will count double towards the LIPHA end of years awards. In order to be eligible for an award in any LIPHA section, the horse, pony or rider must have shown in that section in at least four member shows.
3. **ENTRIES CLOSE TUESDAY MAY 9, 2023. POST ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AT AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF \$25.00 A CLASS.**
4. **Refunds** for entries will be made only upon receipt of a veterinarian's certificate attesting to the inability of horse, due to illness or injury to participate, and the veterinarian's certificate must be received prior to the start of the show. If a horse has shown in one class in a division, it will not be eligible for a refund. Refunds will be mailed. There will be a \$50.00 office charge for all scratches.
5. **Measurement cards and Amateur certification** must be presented at the horse show office before back numbers will be released. To speed processing, management would appreciate exhibitors sending a photocopy with their entry blanks.
6. No entry will be accepted or recorded unless signed by the owner/agent and trainer and the required fees in negotiable funds accompany a completed entry blank.
7. A fee of \$50, plus collection fees, will be charged for all non-negotiable checks.
8. A limited number of permanent stalls are available on a first come, first serve basis. **NO STALLS WILL BE RESERVED WITHOUT ADVANCED PAYMENT and STALL FEES ARE NON REFUNDABLE.** Stall fee is \$200 a day and must be received by the show secretary or before the closing date. **STALLS CLOSING DATE IS APRIL 20, 2023.**
9. Prize money will be awarded by check written to cash if requested. Otherwise it will be subtracted from exhibitors' show bill. All checks will be void after 30 days. The owner of any horse or pony exhibited in classes where prize money is awarded must provide a Social Security or Federal ID on the entry.
10. Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes, and to change ring designations/judges in the interest of time and /or safety. Management reserves the right to limit courtesy circles in accordance with USEF Rule HU120.2.
11. Every animal entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Show Management, their officials, employees and sponsors shall not be liable or responsible for any loss or damage to any animal, person or property, which may occur for any reason during the show and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor hold the LIPHA, and the officials, employees, officers, sponsors and the facilities at which the horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause.
12. Should any questions arise that are not provided for in the rules, the same shall be referred to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.

13. **Dogs and other pets** must be on a leash at all times. A \$50.00 fine will be assessed directly to the entry blank for any violations.
14. **Veterinarian:** The official Show Veterinarian's phone number will be posted at the Horse Show Office.
15. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
16. It is compulsory for riders in all Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation classes where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM /SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. See GR801.2
17. USHJA Horse ID # is required.
18. Mileage to the nearest Hospital and level 1 Trauma Center is 6.47 miles, Stony Brook Hospital in Southampton, NY
19. In addition to the provisions of EQ103.2, HU 101, and JP 100, on or after December 1, 2017, all horses competing in classes that require USHJA horse registration must provide a microchip number that verifies their animal's identity in order to compete for points, money won or be eligible for Federation and/or USHJA programs and awards where horses are required to be recorded or registered.
20. In order to compete in any Hunter/Jumping Seat Equitation classes at licensed competitions as an exhibitor, rider, trainer, or their agent(s), a person must be an Active member of the United States Hunter Jumper Association, Inc., or pay a Show Pass fee to the United States Hunter Jumper Association, Inc. Exception: Local Competitions and exceptions listed in GR901.9. Exception: Breed restricted Hunter/Jumping Seat Equitation classes.
21. Adults can ride ponies in Adult Hunter/Jumping Seat Equitation classes, suitability to count; however, these ponies cannot cross enter into any rated Pony Hunt-er sections (i.e., Children's Hunter Pony, Green Pony Hunter, Regular Pony Hunter), or in WIHS Pony Equitation or USEF Pony Medal classes held at the same competition. See also HU101.



Equitation Rider or the Rider of Hunter Horse/Pony must be a member of the LIPHA **prior to or on the day of** the show. **LIPHA will NOT offer retroactive points!**

- Rider/horse/pony must compete in at least **6 shows** in the **SAME** division during the current competition year that ends August 31<sup>st</sup>,
- The LIPHA reserves the right to combine or split a division at their discretion, either by rider age, or horse/pony size for betterment of program.
- If **Rated** Horseshow must run as unrated due to unforeseen circumstances, such as weather, the points will count toward year end and LIPHA charges will be the same

# LIPHA SPECIFICATIONS FOR 2022/2023

A rider must be a member of the LIPHA and register for award points prior to or on the day of showing to be eligible for a year-end award.

**Rider Eligibility on Ponies:** In accordance with USEF rules, adults may show ponies in classes that are not restricted to junior riders, however that pony may not be shown in any junior exhibitor class at the same show. See USEF rules for Zone and National divisions.

## **CLASS SPECIFICATIONS**

The following classes will follow the USEF Rule Book:

The following sections will follow the USHJA Zone Specifications:

**Children's Hunter Pony, Children's Hunter Horse, Adult Amateur Hunter,  
Children's Jumper, Adult Amateur Jumper, LIPHA Hunter 2'0 & 2'3".**

**LIPHA BEGINNER EQUITATION:** Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday and who have not showed in any class where jumping a course of jumps. Once a rider competes in the mini short stirrup or above, they are no longer eligible for beginner equitation.

**LIPHA MINI SHORT STIRRUP:** Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. Riders who compete in the short stirrup or above are no longer eligible for the mini short stirrup. Riders to jump a course of cross rails not to exceed 18" which will not include a change of direction on course.

**LIPHA SHORT STIRRUP:** A rider who enters and shows in the Short Stirrup Division (Equitation or Hunter) shall not be eligible to enter any other section or division at that show. Riders must be age 12 or under as of December 1 of the current show year. In order to split the section 8 are needed, at least 3 in each section. Section to be split by age. 9 & Under and 10-12. Permissible test for the Short Stirrup Equitation is USEF Hunter Seat Equitation Test #1. (Halt and/or back). Courses for all short stirrup classes must consist of at least six (6) cross rails not to exceed 18". In the Short Stirrup Hunter Section, courses must contain 1 change of direction. Equitation will be split by age for year-end awards if there are at least 3 entries in each group.

**LIPHA LOW CHILDREN/ADULT HUNTERS:** Open to juniors & adults. Two sections must be offered: Ponies and Horses. If there are less than 3 entries in either the Pony section or the Horse section, both sections must be combined. Ponies to jump 2' and horses to jump 2'6". Riders may not cross enter the Children's or Adult Amateur Hunter division or any class/section where fences exceed 2'9" (Exception 3'0" Equitation). If entries warrant, the division may be split for year-end awards.

**LIPHA LOW CHILDREN HORSE/ADULT EQUITATION:** Open to junior & adult exhibitors. Fences 2'. Three sections must be offered: Ponies, Horses and Adult. Riders may not cross enter into any other equitation class or hunter class where fences exceed 2'6" The specifications will follow USHJA specifications.

**LIPHA CHILDREN HUNTER HORSE:** Combined award Rider 14 & under and 15 to 17. May be split at shows if there are more than 3 entries at managers discretion. Year-end awards will be split if more than 6 entries or at LIPHA discretion.

**LIPHA ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER:** Combined Award Younger & Older divisions. May be split at shows if entries warrant at managements discretion.

**LIPHA/USHJA 2'0 & 2'3" HUNTER DIVISIONS:** Open to all riders not competing in class where height exceeds 2'3 for 2'0 riders or 2'6" for 2'3" riders. To be run in accordance of USHJA specifications

# LIPHA SPECIFICATIONS FOR 2022/2023

**LIPHA PRE-MINI 2'6" MEDAL/MEDIUM ADULT MEDAL EQUITATION:** Division makes up combination of Medal, Maclay and PHA equitation classes that are a modified version of the courses used in the National Medal Classes. Exhibitors must have not won three (3) blue ribbons in any 3' or higher equitation class. Riders may not compete in any classes exceeding 2'6" at the same show that they compete in the Pre-Mini or Medium Adult Division. Fences not to exceed 2'6".

**LIPHA ROSS REISNER MINI MEDAL:** Division makes up combination of Medal, Maclay and PHA equitation classes that are a modified version of the courses used in the National Medal Classes (3'6" and 3' classes). Fences at 3'0".

**LIPHA HIGH ADULT MEDAL:** Division makes up combination of Medal, Maclay and PHA equitation classes that are a modified version of the courses used in the National Medal Classes (3'6" and 3' classes). Fences at 3'0". May be combined with Ross Reisner Mini Medal if there are fewer than 3 entries at horseshow. For LIPHA year-end awards, this class will be combined with Ross Reisner Mini Medal unless there are at least three qualified adult riders.

**\*\* COMBINING JUMPER SECTIONS AT SHOWS:** If there are fewer than 3 entries in any section, the sections may be combined at management's discretion allowing each section to compete at their respective height to fill division. ## **USHJA Competitive Program Specs**

### **USHJA Green Hunter Incentive Program**

Open to horses of any age that are eligible to compete as a Green Hunter under USEF rules, the Green Hunter Incentive Program features stake classes, six Platinum Performance/USHJA Green Hunter Incentive Regional Championships and the annual Platinum Performance/USHJA Green Hunter Incentive Championship. Horses must be enrolled in the program prior to competing. Enrollment is currently open with a \$550 fee until June 1. The fee increases to \$750 from June 2 until November 30.

Additionally, owners may purchase enrollment slots at the current rate and designate the specific horse(s) to them at a later date this year through their USHJA member account. Only results achieved by the horse after it is assigned to the slot will count in program standings. Slots expire at the end of the competition year the same as the regular enrollment and are non-transferrable.
