### Weather & Attire - Dress Warmly and Wear Navy on Hill Day!

The recommended attire for the NAHN Hispanic Health Policy Summit is professional attire with comfortable shoes. No attire with political statements or messages will be permitted. **Attendees are encouraged to wear navy blue for visits on the Hill on Wednesday, February 11.** Temperatures in Washington, DC are expected to be cold, with an average between 24°F as a low and 35°F as a high. Attendees should check the weather forecast and pack accordingly.

### Prohibited Items - Please Note Large Bag Rules

To ensure the safety and security of the U.S. Capitol Complex, certain items **(included on this list)** are prohibited from being brought into the Capitol Buildings and Grounds. While this may be a small inconvenience, planning ahead by leaving these items at home will allow for an expeditious security screening process. Failure to adhere to these established regulations can result in arrest, fine, and/or imprisonment, as well as the confiscation and/or destruction of the item. This list is not intended to be all-encompassing but to serve as a general guide for what is and is not allowed to be brought into the various buildings on the Capitol Grounds. Please note that bags exceeding the

size of 18" wide x 14" high x 8.5" deep are prohibited in the Senate Office Buildings, House Office Buildings, and Library of Congress Buildings.


### Summit Program, Speaker Bios, and Continuing Education
