



Step 1

Step 2

Step 3

Complete personal information, and select Referee as position. Add referee experience and applicable levels.

Volunteer with Brams United

1. After you have successfully set up a PowerUp Account you will then need to submit an application to volunteer.
2. Login to your account and click on Volunteer Now! on the left panel
3. Select Team Official Application
4. Select the appropriate season (e.g., Summer, Fall) for when you'll be volunteering.
5. Once your application has been approved, you're ready to coach!
6. Brams United coaches receive 20 volunteer hours for each indoor season and 40 hours for summer outdoor season.
